

NORTH DAKOTA CERTIFICATE OF EXEMPT STATUS

****For internal Indiana University use only****

NOTE: According to North Dakota Century Code, 57-39.2-04, Indiana University is authorized for exemption from sales tax on purchases, rentals and leases of tangible personal property for its exclusive use. The University must issue the attached certificate to vendors when purchasing tangible personal property or taxable services to qualify for the exemption.

- Indiana University must be the direct purchaser and payer of record. Purchases must be made in the following manner:
 - Are directly invoiced and charged to Indiana University, and
 - Are directly paid by Indiana University via
 - check,
 - credit card
- All purchases must benefit the University only. The form may not be used for the benefit of any officer, member, or employee of Indiana University.
- The purchases must be directly related to the University's exempt purpose.

- Provide a copy of the certificate to each vendor when making exempt purchases.
